Dear Friends of Life,

2024 has been a productive year for PCUC, as we enter this month of December. But our recent election has given me HOPE that <u>we can do more</u>. If anything, we learned that we cannot believe what the media and the pollsters tell us. If the polls were correct, then it wouldn't have been such a landslide victory for President Trump. Supposedly, according to the polls, almost 2 out of 3 people favor making abortion legal in all or most cases. Maybe that's not completely true, and there is an opportunity to ignite a dialogue that can change hearts and minds in this country on behalf of the lives of the unborn.

**Our PCUC Billboard Project has been the start of that campaign in Pittsburgh.** As most of you know, PCUC has been running 4 digital billboards that can be seen at different times on Route 28, the Parkway West, the Parkway East, I-79, and in front of the Squirrel Hill tunnel. This is just the start of what we hope will become an even larger campaign of Pro-Life billboards around the city; <u>we need to</u> <u>do more</u>.

Another project we started this year was the creation of a PCUC Communications committee that has started a letter writing campaign to various publications and politicians. # FROM OUR DIRECTOR GOD HEARS OUR PRAYERS!

As I thought about my message for this newsletter, the theme of PRAYER

kept coming to mind.

If you are like me, you might have the tendency to get focused on "tasks" and put prayer on the backburner...because, after all, we can see with our eyes the results of our "works", but have to rely on faith when it comes to prayer. Yes, there is a lot of "Martha" in me, and not enough "Mary".

So, with that in mind, I want to share a story that illustrates just how powerful prayer is:

Last month my husband had a collapsed lung and was taken to Presbyterian Hospital by ambulance, and Jen immediately sent out a prayer request to our 40 Days for Life email list, asking people to pray for him. Shortly after the prayer request went out, Joe was put in the ER examining room, where a doctor prepared to insert a tube into his chest to release the air in his chest cavity. The procedure is done with no anesthesia and is quite painful, so Joe was pretty scared. Just as the doctor was getting ready to make the incision, another doctor peeked his head into the room and asked if a group of nursing students could observe the procedure. *If you know my husband, you know that he loves to be the center of attention, so of course, he invited them in!* 

As the young women crowded into the room, I noticed their smocks were marked, "Franciscan University". Knowing of the faithfulness of Franciscan students, I said to Joe, "You are really lucky to have seven Franciscan Students here to watch!"

As the doctor made the incision and began to insert the tube, Joe was feeling a lot of pain, and he asked the students, "Girls, would you mind praying for me?" All seven began to pray the "Our Father", "Hail Mary" and "Glory Be", in unison...which was beautiful. After they were finished, Joe was really in pain, and he asked them, "Girls...would you mind singing 'Immaculate Mary' for me?" They looked at each other, smiling, and they all decided to hum the song, instead. It was heavenly! They sounded like a choir of angels, humming "Immaculate Mary" in perfect harmony, for about 10 minutes...until the procedure was over. Joe joined in as he was able, and it brought him the strength and peace he needed to be able to get through it. When it was over, I asked the doctor who did the procedure if he had ever experienced anything like that before. He said, "No, never!"

I share this story as a reminder of the importance of prayer, and to help us realize just how much God loves us and wants to answer our prayers!

First of all, can anyone deny that God heard our prayers for the election? It truly appears that we have been granted a reprieve, however long or short it may be. I think we have been given this reprieve...not so that we can sit back and put our feet up...NO! Now is the time to continue to storm Heaven with our prayers and sacrifices, to beg for the grace of REPENTANCE and REVIVAL for our nation! The guilt of more than 65 million innocent babies is upon us, and without repentance, the evil that was about to over-take us in November will surely be back.

So...PRAYER is our theme for this coming new year, and there are many ways you can be involved.

The brochure exposes what we know about the collection of baby body parts from babies aborted at Magee and used at Pitt and elsewhere for macabre testing and experimentation. The Communications Committee is promoting a **letter writing campaign** for early January to get the attention of our new senator, **Dave McCormick**. For this to effectively demonstrate broad support for protecting human life and dignity, we need the senator's office to receive a **large volume of letters**..

Please contact newly elected Senator Dave McCormick between **January 3rd and January 24** (the March for Life) to urge him to support federal legislation to protect children before they are born.

Section 5 of the 14th Amendment authorizes Congress to enforce the 14th amendment's protections for life. Legislation in prior Congresses has been introduced to protect life beginning at conception.

Encourage Senator McCormick to work with his colleagues on this critical matter and to support such legislation in the new Congress.

With Republican majorities in both chambers of Congress and President Trump back in office, now is the time to write to Senator McCormick to let him know that you support action on federal pro-life legislation.

And can you do us a favor and **let Kathy know** when you write, so we can have an idea of the volume of response?


Pastor Dan Hendley led dozens of participants in prayer and song, and in a Jericho March around PP on Nov. 3rd.
